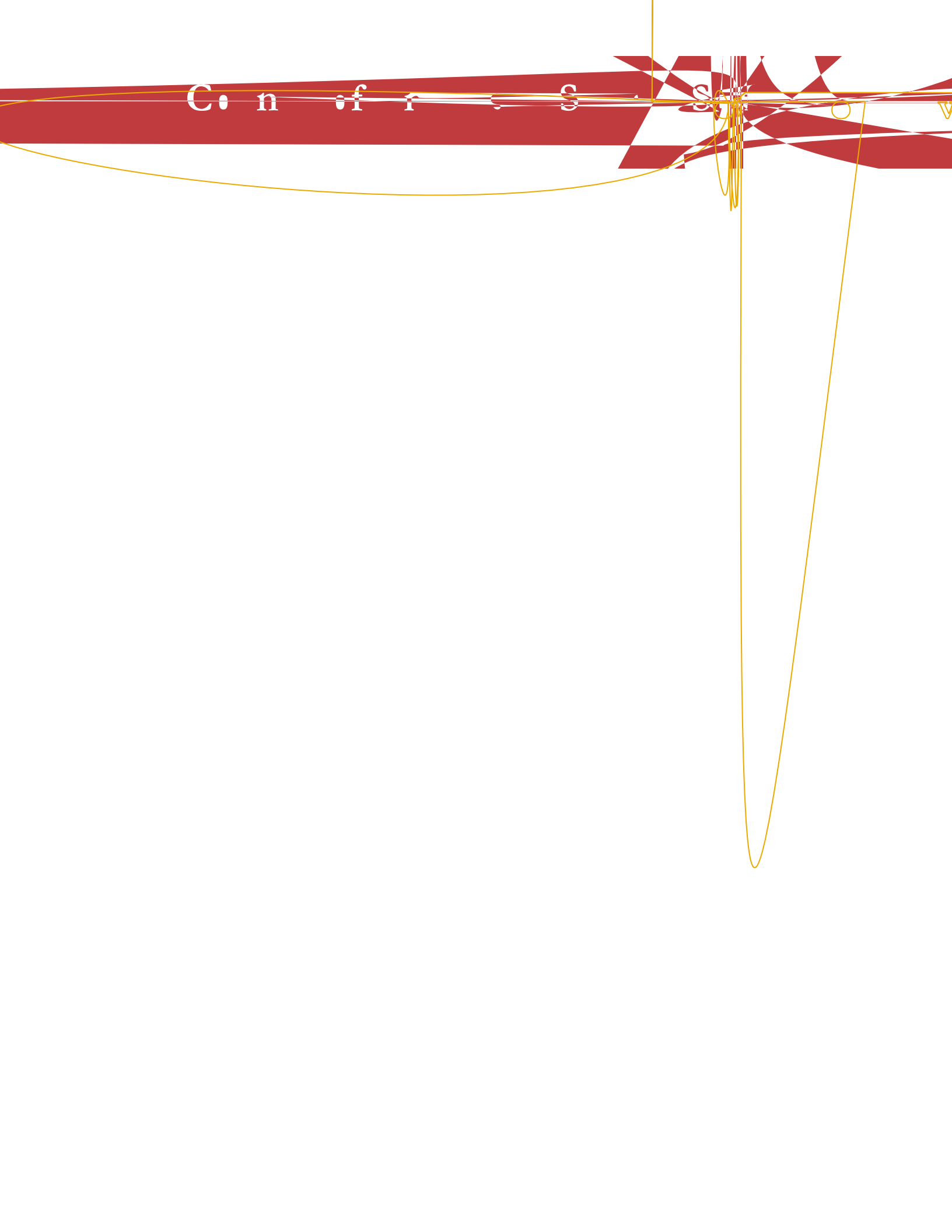

SU's 6th Annual Research Day, sponsored by the Office of Graduate Studies & Research, was recently held in the Academic Commons Assembly Hall which featured faculty research from a variety of specializations.

SU alumna and staff member, Catherine Neighbors, is the first Certified Healthcare Simulation Educator on the Eastern Shore. There are 28 across the state of Maryland. SU's Simulation Center has four specialized simulation suites, seven high-fidelity patient simulators, classroom and debriefing spaces, and a standardized patient program. Opened in 2011, it is designed to be a "safe space" for students and others to practice skills as health professionals.

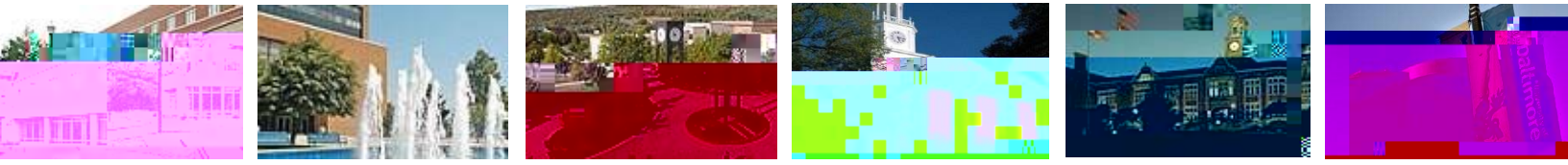
The memorial for Patty Kirwan (wife of former Chancellor Brit Kirwan) took place on October 18 in the Memorial Chapel.
